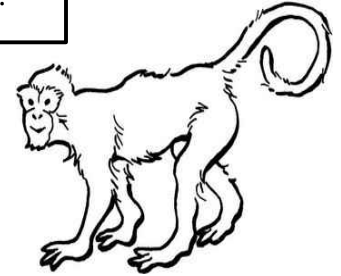
A-Maze-ing Primates

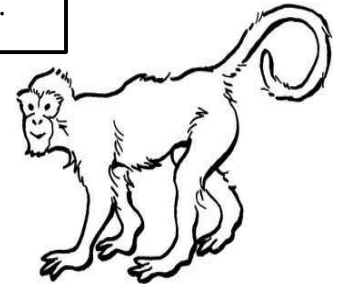
