"That's what I thought, too," said Lexie. "Then I changed my mind."

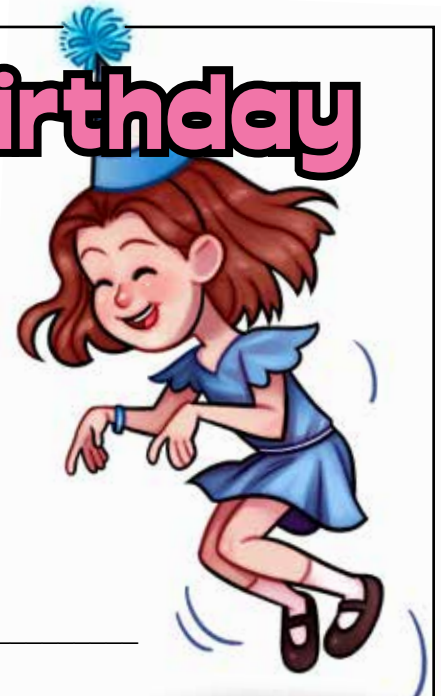
"Why?" asked Rose.
