


stuck out of the end of its tail.

The Stegosaurus was probably not very smart. Its brain was the size of a walnut.

Scientists once thought Stegosaurus used the plates for protection. The plates made Stegosaurus look larger and tougher. But the plates weren't very strong. They had hollow sections that might have contained blood vessels. So now scientists think the plates helped Stegosaurus keep its body at the right temperature.

Stegosaurus probably did use its tail spikes to fight off meat-eaters like Allosaurus. It also might have traveled in herds for extra protection.






