Combining Like Terms



Terms are separated by + or - signs in an expression.

Like terms may be combined according to the sign that separates them.

example: $8u + 5 - 4u - 3f + 2$

$8u - 4u$ $5 + 2$

$4u + 7 - 3f$

* Include symbol when identifying terms.
