## Phonics: Ch Words Card Game

These cards can be used many different ways.

## Here are a few ideas:

1. Memory Match Game

Flip the cards upside-down on a table. Students take turns flipping pairs of cards. If students flip two cards that go together (ex: picture of a chair and the word chair.), then they get to keep both cards. The plaver with the most matches

## 4. Dry Erase Writing

Laminate the picture cards. Students can use dry erase markers to complete the words on the cards.
