## Phonics: Long-O Card Game

These cards can be used many different ways.

## Here are a few ideas:

## 1. Memory Match Game

Flip the cards upside-down on a table. Students take turns flipping pairs of cards. If students flip two cards that go together (ex: picture of soap and the word soap.), then they get to keep both cards. The player with the most matches wins.


## 4. Alphabetical Order

Cut apart the word cards. Have students place them in a line, in alphabetical order.
