Building Shapes

Objective:

• Student will build polygons

Materials:

- toothpicks or small pretzel sticks
- clay or Play Doh
- chart (on the following page)

Directions:

- Students can use the illustrations to help them build the two-dimensional (flat) shapes listed on the chart.
- Small balls of clay or Play Doh can be used to fasten the ends of the sticks



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students may need to work with an adult.

• Feel free to substitute different materials. You might use craft sticks or dry spaghetti noodles instead of toothpicks. You might use marshmallows instead of clay.

Discussion:

- Which shape has the most sides? Which shape has the fewest?
- Which shape was the most difficult to build? Why?
- Would you have been able to build a circle? Why or why not?
