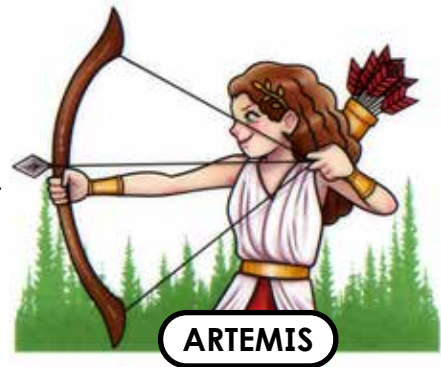

Match and Glue

Give your students large pieces of 9 x 12 construction paper and the puzzle pieces. Have students find matching Greek deities and descriptions. They can glue the matches onto the paper.

Find the Incorrect Match

Attach three puzzle piece pairs to a sheet of construction paper. Two matches should be correct. One should be incorrect. Laminate. Have students identify the incorrect match.

Race to Match

Give two (or more) students a set of Greek deity puzzle cards. Have them race to see who can correctly match all of the cards first.
