Adding -ed and -ing

For words that end with the letter **y**, change the **y** to an **i** before adding **-ed**.

example: Jen dried her hair. (dry + ed = dried)

Do not take away the **y** when you add **-ing**.

example: Matt is drying his shirt. (dry + ing = drying)
