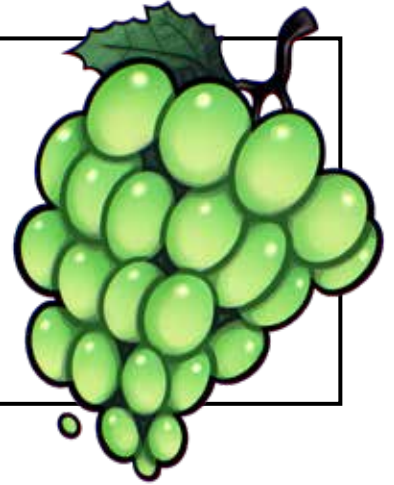
## Subjects & Predicates

The **subject** of a sentence tells who or what the sentence is about.

The **predicate** of a sentence tells what the subject does or is.

**example:** The green grapes grew on the vine.

*The green grapes are the subject, and  
grew on the vine is the predicate.*
