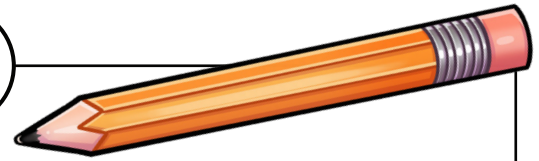


Peer Editing
