“Yay! Let’s go back to the store!”

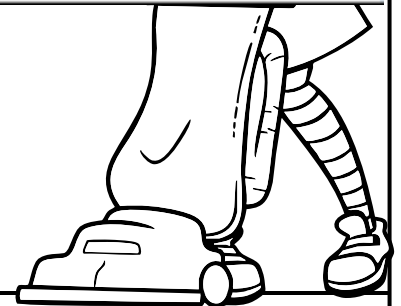
