Did you know that trees are some of the oldest living things on the planet? Many trees live for hundreds of years.

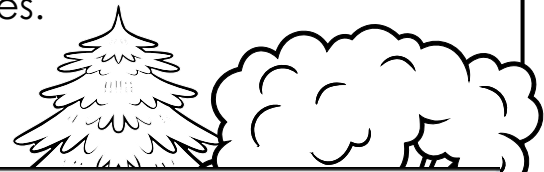
There are many different species of trees. Scientists divide trees into different groups based on how they reproduce and the tree's leaves.

Most trees reproduce or make more trees by spreading seeds. Some trees grow their seeds in cones. These trees are called conifers.

Trees are also grouped based on whether they lose their leaves or not. Trees that lose their leaves during the fall and winter are called deciduous trees. Trees that do not lose their leaves are called evergreen trees.
