Il tortoises are turtles. But all turtles are not tortoises.

Tortoises live on land. Some lie in shallow water or mud to cool off. But they aren't built for swimming. They have thick legs. These legs help carry their weight as they walk.

Turtles that are not tortoises often spend time in water. They have flatter and thinner shells than tortoises. This makes it easier to swim. Some even have webbed feet.

Sea turtles live in the ocean. They have

flippers. The flippers help them swim great distances. They breathe air like other turtles. They can hold their breath for many hours. They can even sleep underwater!

Female sea turtles only leave the ocean to lay eggs. Male sea turtles do not leave the ocean.

Turtles can be big or small. The smallest can weigh less than a deck of cards. The largest tortoises can weigh as much as a male African lion. The largest turtle of all, however, is the leatherback sea turtle. Some weigh as much as a polar bear!


