

Tornado Alley mostly follows an invisible line. The line starts near the U.S.-Mexico border and goes north into Canada. West of the line is drier air. East of the line is wetter air. It's not an official area with start and end spots. Still, big parts of Texas, Oklahoma, Kansas, Nebraska, South Dakota, and Iowa are always included in Tornado Alley. The first-ever official tornado

warning was given in 1948 in Oklahoma City!

The wet-dry line moves back and forth as the seasons change. That means tornado season isn't the same everywhere. In Oklahoma, it can peak in May. In Iowa or Minnesota, it can peak in June and July. In recent years the line has also moved farther north and east. Places like Michigan and Mississippi have seen more tornadoes—and stronger ones




