The World's Tallest Flying Bird

ou may know the ostrich is the tallest living bird. However, the tallest living bird that flies is one you may not have heard of. It's the sarus crane!

Sarus cranes are the largest species of crane. They get most of their height from long legs and a long neck. Some males stand 6 feet (1.8 meters) tall and have a wingspan of nearly 9 feet (2.7 meters).

Sarus cranes' bodies are mostly gray. They have red heads and pink legs. Most live in marshes and wet plains in Southeast Asia. However, in the 1960s, some were also discovered living in northern Australia.

Pairs mate for life. They work together building a nest in or near shallow water. The location might be in a natural wetland or in a flooded farm field. The nest is huge at 6 feet (1.8 meters) wide and 3 feet (1 meter) high. The nest may be used for years.


The female lays one or two

However, the biggest threat to sarus cranes is loss of wetland habitat. Although considered sacred in much of Asia, the crane continues to lose wetland habitat to agriculture. Some organizations and communities where sarus cranes live are working to conserve these habitats.






