"Hi, Mya!" replied Milo. "How was school?"

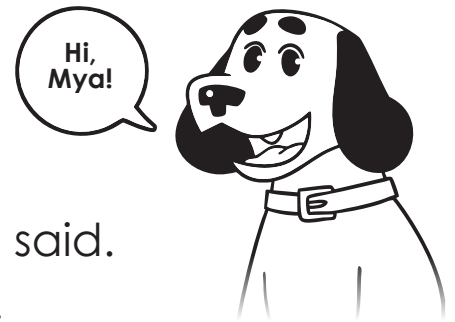
Mya told Milo all about her day. She asked him about his too. Milo had played with his favorite toy, chewed his favorite bone, and barked at the mailman.
