Ruby threw the ball. It went to the right of the can. "I missed."

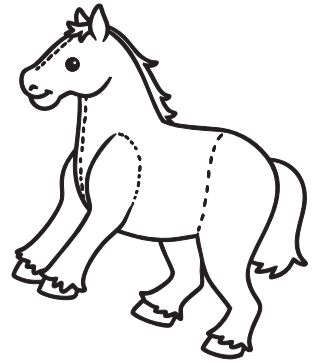
"Two more tries," the man said.
